Victim: NAKED EDGE CUTLERY,

MS RENITA O'FARRILL, OFFICE MANAGER FOR THE CORPORATE OFFICE OF NAKED EDGE CUTLERY CALLED REGARDING A MOTOR VEHICLE THEFT. SHE HAD REPORTED A COMPANY-OWNED VEHICLE AS STOLEN EARLIER TODAY (02-112305). MS O'FARRILL SAID SHE RECEIVED A CALL FROM THE STORE MANAGER WHO TOLD HER THE VEHICLE WAS NOW BEHIND THE STORE AND THE KEYS THAT WERE MISSING

WERE IN IT. MS O'FARRILL TOLD ME THAT THE VEHICLE WAS ON THE WAY TO THE CONIFER OFFICE SO IT WAS NOT AVAILABLE FOR PROCESSING.

MS O'FARRILL SAID THAT THE SUSPECT IN THE THEFT WAS A CONTRACT EMPLOYEE WHO DID PROMOTIONAL AND ADVERTISING WORK FOR THE COMPANY. WHILE HE WAS WORKING THERE, STEVE GARTIN PURCHASED SOME COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, USING COMPANY FUNDS WHICH HE USED AS A PART OF HIS DUTIES. MR GARTIN WAS AT THE STORE ON 8-28-02 AND WHEN THE EMPLOYEES RETURNED ON 9-03-02, THE COMPUTER EQUIPMENT WAS MISSING. MS O'FARRILL TOLD ME THAT THE SUSPECT DID NOT HAVE PERMISSION TAKE ANY OF THE EQUIPMENT. MS O'FARRILL WILL RESEARCH THE DETAILS/DESCRIPTION OF THE STOLEN ITEMS.

MS O'FARRILL TOLD ME THAT SUSPECT HAD ONLY COMMUNICATED WITH COMPANY REPRESENTATIVES VIA E-MAIL SINCE HE LEFT. HE WAS SENT AN E-MAIL TODAY REQUESTING THAT HE RETURN THE COMPANY VEHICLE OR THE POLICE WOULD BE CONTACTED. SHE SUSPECTED THAT RESULTED IN THE VEHICLE BEING RETURNED. MS O'FARRILL SAID THAT THE LAST KNOWN PHONE NUMBER FOR THE SUSPECT WAS DISCONNECTED AND SHE DID NOT KNOW WHERE OR HOW TO LOCATE HIM.

I CHECKED CCIC AND DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE FILES FOR A STEVEN GARTIN AND FOUND A STEVE DOUGLAS GARTIN, DOB 3-20-49 WHO IS THE SUBJECT OF SEVERAL RESTRAINING ORDERS. HE IS ALSO LISTED A PROBATION CLIENT FROM THE COLORADO ATTORNEY GENERAL'S SPECIAL PROSECUTION UNIT. I DID NOT LOCATE A DRIVER'S LICENSE FOR GARTIN.

THE STOLEN VEHICLE HAD NOT YET BEEN ENTERED ON CCIC/NCIC. IT WAS CANCELLED UNDER TTY# R5354.

NO ADDITIONAL INFORMATION WAS DEVELOPED.
