Call Completed	3/31/2004	1:00 PM	<p>Attorney Miller call to District Attorney: Trial Preparation</p> <p>DETAILS:</p> <p>On, or about, 4 March 2004 Attorney Miller informed me that he was renegeing on all the legal work that he had formerly committed to after the 8 April 2004 motions hearing in Jefferson County.</p> <p>Attorney Miller advised me that he would continue with the Flagstaff incident until it was resolved, either by trial or a dismissal.</p> <p>I was not privvy to this Status Conference between Attorney Miller and the Coconino County District Attorney.</p>
Call Completed	1/28/2004	1:00 PM	<p>Conference with Thomas Cecil Miller: Entry of Appearance</p> <p>DETAILS:</p> <p>Attorney Miller spoke with the District Attorney for Coconino County, who informed him that no charges had been filed at that time. Attorney Miller noticed the D.A. that he would be entering on the case when and if charges were filed. A follow up call was scheduled for March 31, 2004 as a status meeting.</p> <p>I was present in Attorney Miller's office when this call was made.</p>
Meeting Held	12/17/2003	2:00 PM	<p>Special Appearance to Challenge Jurisdiction</p> <p>DETAILS:</p> <p>While at the court I met two other out of state victims stopped for "seat belt" violations, trucks towed, unlawful searches and arrests.</p> <p>Looks like a R.I.C.O.</p> <p>Judge Kolb did not understand my challenge of jurisdiction, standing and capacity or anything else. When I mentioned that I worked for an attorney, the judge suggested that the D.A. speak with him and arranged a conference call for 28 January, 2004.</p> <p>D.A. has not yet established jurisdiction.</p>
Meeting Held	11/17/2003	12:05 AM	<p>Traffick Revenue Stop by Officer Stephen Robson</p> <p>DETAILS:</p> <p>Stephen Robson stopped us at milepost 205 on InterState 40 for a cracked windshield. He then placed his hand on his gun and demanded I.D. from everyone in the car.
